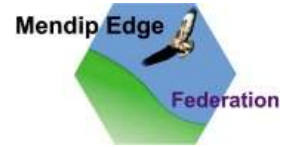

This year our Health Education Programme for the whole school will be from **Tuesday 11 February – Thursday 13 February** inclusive. For these three days the normal timetable is suspended and pupils work with their year teams (Year Heads and the tutor teams) on health related issues.

The programmes are as follows:-

- Year 5 – Drug Education
- Year 6 – Relationships and Sex Education (RSE)
- Year 7 – Physical and Emotional Wellbeing; Staying Safe
- Year 8 – Further Relationships and Sex Education (RSE)

Our four year programme aims to support children as they grow up. Our objectives are to give the children the knowledge they need to make informed choices as they progress into adolescence, as well as to foster and develop qualities essential to leading a happy and fulfilled life. These qualities include self-esteem, confidence and self-understanding as well as the recognition of positive relationships built on friendship and love. We recognise the delicate balance between preserving the children’s innocence and increasing their necessary understanding as they become young adults.
