The parents' information evening for the Year 5 residential visit to Osmington Bay is taking place on **Wednesday 4 March at 7.00pm**. The meeting will be held in the school hall. Pupils are not expected to attend this meeting as they will be given all the information about the trip, during their school assembly.

The purpose of the evening is to explain the itinerary and organisation for the week, to meet the accompanying staff and to answer any questions you may have. An information booklet will be available on the school web-site. If you do not have access to a computer, please let your child's tutor know and a hard copy will be supplied.

A medical form for you to complete and return to school is attached. This must be returned to enable your child to participate in the activity week.

If you have not already completed payment, full payment is due by the 20<sup>th</sup> March please. Pocket money is included in your payment and will be given to pupils while we are away, on a daily basis.

It is school policy that if any pupil breaks the rules or behaves in an inappropriate manner, pocket money for a day will be withheld. The money will be returned on the coach coming home, or forwarded to parents with an explanatory letter upon our return to school. If we feel any pupil is behaving in an unacceptable manner while we are away, putting themselves or others at risk, we will telephone home and ask you to come and collect your child.

We stress that pocket money is not withheld for minor misbehaviour and, to date, it has not been necessary to send any pupil home.
