Unfortunately, the company that organises the Bag2School scheme has not been able to access the bags they usually supply, so please can we ask you to use your own black bin bags or carrier bags.

The information supplied on the Bag2School bags is:

Bag2School is a company that specialises in good quality second hand clothing that can be re-used. All bags are weighed and the donation is paid based on the total weight collected. The more you weigh the more we pay!

We collect good quality adult and children's clothing, paired shoes, hats, belts, handbags, soft toys, bedding, curtains and towels.

We do NOT accept duvets, pillows or cushions.

Thank you for your support and I hope this gives you the opportunity you have been waiting for to clear out your wardrobes and make space for all your Christmas presents and summer clothes!
